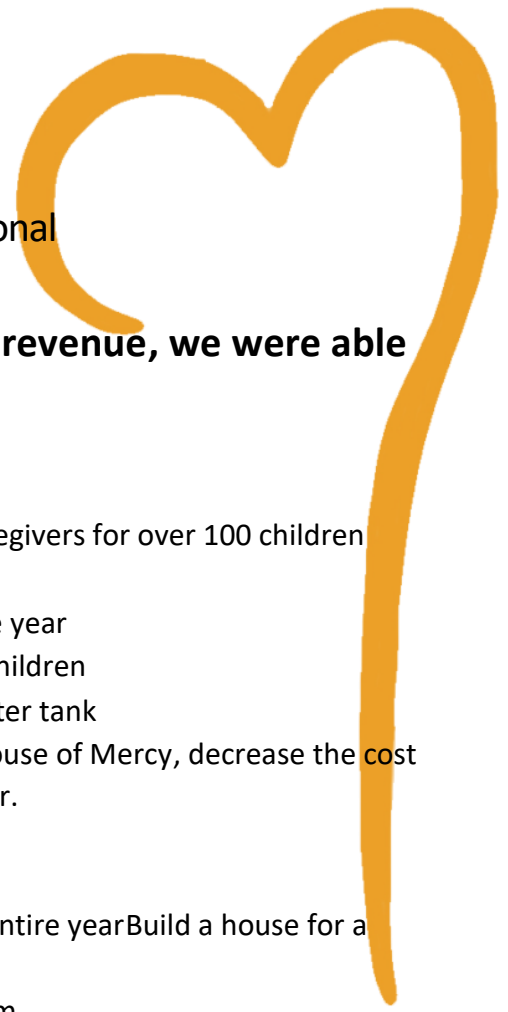


Year in Review 2018

**With \$158,000 in donations and special event revenue, we were able to do the following:**

**Children**

- Provided food, medical care, housing, clothing, and caregivers for over 100 children
- Send 120 Kenyan children to school all year
- Educate 100 children in rural Mozambique for an entire year
- Provide uniforms and shoes for more than 50 Kenyan children
- Increase water supply at House of Mercy with giant water tank
- Begin sewing project to benefit special needs kids at House of Mercy, decrease the cost of school uniforms and provide employment for teacher.

**Families**

- Provide employment for 21 people in E. Africa for the entire year
- Build a house for a single mom in rural village in Western Kenya
- Provide startup capital for small business for single mom
- Provided rain barrel system for Mama Robert to have clean water
- Train and send out 4 interns who are all employed and using their gifts
- Provide rent for farm land for one family for the year
- Pay for medical costs and burial for son of our House Mother at HOM

**Missions**

- Support a missionary and his family for the entire year resulting in one new church plant and dozens of baptisms
- Send over 2 short term teams involving 6 people whom are all active in supporting the work
- Support the work of the Sauls, who are American missionaries in Kisii, by providing \$500, flooring for their chicken house, helping lead worship at U-turn, prayer support.

**Community Development**

- Complete a second school building in Rural Mozambique
- Built new toilets at Mission Station in Mozambique
- Finished the kitchen area at Mission Station in Mozambique
- Grow the poultry project from 1500 chicks to 1750
- Purchase a vehicle and new tires to help deliver eggs for poultry project
