A 6 YEAR JOURNEY

In 2015 we began dreaming about how to start an income generating project in Kenya that would provide an income to sustain the local ministry work. God had already given our partners a vision for a poultry project. We asked you all to contribute and you provided the first 500 hens in 2016.

Fast forward to December of 2021, we purchased the last set of laying hens for our poultry project in central Kenya, bringing the total number of laying hens to 6,000!

By May of 2022, the project will not only fully support the local ministry work, but also provide full time income for 6 people and a protein supply for the local area.

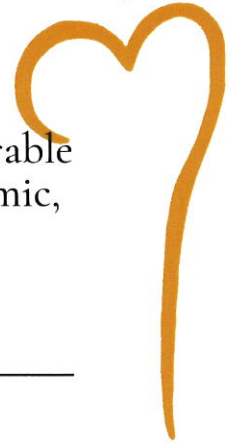
- Housed and fully cared for more than 45 children for an entire year, supporting them with food, medical care, supplies, school fees, etc.
- Provided scholarships for 15 college students and over 100 high school and primary students.
- Provided full time jobs for 16 Kenyans.
- Provided monthly emergency food to more than 30 families.
- Added 4,000 hens to the poultry project.
- Finished building 4 homes.
- Began distributing sanitary supplies to 750 high school girls monthly and clothing to 750 boys monthly.
- Purchased more than 100 Bibles to be distributed in rural Kenya.
